Volunteer Program

Through the **Volunteer Program**, the Foundation recognizes and rewards personal involvement by active employees and retirees of Alliant Energy and its family of companies.

Program participants who give their own time to support a wide array of causes and events in their communities are eligible for a grant, up to **\$400** annually, to eligible charitable organizations of their choosing located in Iowa, Minnesota or Wisconsin.

Grants up to **\$400** will be awarded in the name of an eligible participant (or anonymously, if the participant chooses) based on the total number of hours volunteered.

In preparation for a new online giving website, in 2017 we are adjusting the annual schedule for payouts from the volunteer program. In 2018 and beyond, volunteer grants will be based on a 12-month calendar year (January 1 through December 31). For 2017, grant payments will be paid in September as usual. However, in order to accommodate the timing of our new system, grant payments will be made again in February 2018 based upon the adjusted schedule at right. For the 2018 volunteer program year, we will return to the standard 12-month payout amounts.

Matching Gifts

Through the **Matching Gifts Program**, the Foundation matches – dollar for dollar – each direct gift of **\$50** or more (**up to \$2,500**) made to one or more eligible institutions or organizations within a calendar year.



In order to be matched, each gift must be made to a charitable organization holding a current Section 501(c)(3) designation letter from the Internal Revenue Service and located in Iowa, Minnesota or Wisconsin. However, we also will match a donation to a college or university located outside of these states if the retiree graduated from the institution.

A gift made in support of a library, museum, zoo, etc., which is operated by a governmental entity would also qualify for a matching gift.

Some examples of eligible organizations include:

- Public radio and television
- Public and private schools, Kindergarten – 12th grade (holding their own 501(c)(3))
- Cultural arts organizations
- Environmental organizations
- Hospice programs and hospitals
- Historic sites and museums

Your gift must qualify as fully deductible for income tax purposes. Gifts may be made to one or more eligible institutions or organizations within the calendar year but they must be paid, not merely pledged.
